- 5. Roll call 35 present. 33 absent (per bylaws a quorum was present)
- 6. Motion made by **Tom Miller** to approve the December 2024 minutes, seconded by **Vicky Boegel**. Motion carried (voice vote)
- 7. Jamie Zehren read the bills. Motion made by **Don Miller** to approve the bills as read, seconded by **Tom Miller**. Motion carried (voice vote)
